


Were you at the AEBG Summit last year?





What would best describe your role?






2016 AEGB Summit Moving the Needle

November 1-2, 2016 Sacramento. CA

The 2016 AEBG Summit: *Moving the Needle* featured presentations, panel discussions, networking, and the sharing of best practices focusing on the impact AEBG consortia are having on developing a stronger California Workforce. Presenters also examined will the long term vision for AEBG and to see what more can be done to improve our adult education system across the state.

The summit took place on November 1, 10:30AM to 5:00PM with networking reception and November 2, 8:30AM to 12:30PM at the Sheraton Grand Hotel in Sacramento. Regional consortia were invited to register up to four representatives. These representatives included consortia leaders, member representatives, faculty, teachers, and consortia staff.




How satisfied were you with the 2016 AEBG Summit OVERALL?






How satisfied were you with the 2016 AEBG Summit OVERALL?






How satisfied were you with the REGISTRATION process for the event?




How satisfied were you with the FOOD at the event?






How satisfied were you with the event's MOBILE APP?






How satisfied were you with the event's MOBILE APP?










How satisfied were you with the LOCATION of the event?




How satisfied were you with the TIMING of the event?







