Academic Senate Statewide Noncredit Committee

- Updating the 2009 Senate paper entitled "Noncredit Instruction: Opportunity and Challenge"
- Discussed, amended, and voted on resolutions during Fall Plenary session Nov. 1-3, 2018
- Noncredit resolutions that pass will be forwarded to appropriate Senate committee for action.

Resolutions That Affect Noncredit

- Redefine the Faculty Obligation Number to Include Noncredit Faculty
- FON has at many colleges been treated as a maximum number of full-time faculty to be employed rather than as the minimum. Progress has not been achieved toward reaching the legislative goal of 75% of instruction by full-time faculty.
- With the implementation of AB705 many colleges are exploring an expansion of noncredit offerings but noncredit faculty not included in FON creating a disincentive to hiring or assigning full-time faculty in an area of significant student need.

Resolutions that Affect Noncredit

9.02 F18 Equalize Noncredit Curriculum Processes to Align with Local Approval of Credit Curriculum Processes

- ▶ Since October 2016, colleges can now self-certify curriculum for credit courses, modified credit programs with the exception of ADT, and new credit programs with a goal of local program with the exception of new career technical education credit programs and apprenticeship.
- Noncredit course approval process must be nimble enough to allow for colleges to increase in-demand noncredit course offerings.
- Recommend to work with Chancellor's Office and other stakeholders to equalize noncredit curriculum processes to align with local approval.

California Community College Curriculum Committee

- ▶ **5Cs** is a recommending body that provides policy and guidance on all matters related to curriculum, including creation, implementation and endorsement of curriculum through the California Community College system.
- ▶ Noncredit Workgroup:
- 1. Guidelines to noncredit prerequisites to credit courses
- 2. Clarification if noncredit co-requisite can be required
- 3. Update on streamlining of mirrored course approval
- ▶ 4. Noncredit work experience/internships next steps
- ▶ 5. Noncredit distance ed next steps
