Curriculum

- CCCCCO streamlining curriculum approval process
- Significant progress made
- Proposal presented to BOG January 17, 2017
- Changes enable colleges to be more responsive to local curricular needs
- CCCCCO to automatically approve credit courses upon release of new COCI in late Spring 2017
- **Noncredit courses and programs not included at this time**
- Academic Affairs Memo AA 17-01 released January 23, 2017 to CIO listserv



Chancellor's Office Curriculum Inventory (COCI)

- Pilot colleges are currently in program test phase
- All technical issues in COCI 1.0 are current
- CCCCCO utilizing Zoom software to provide technical assistance to colleges

CCCCO Work Related to Noncredit

Satisfactory Progress Indicator

- BOG Approval in September 2016
- Added to title 5
- Optional evaluative symbol, not mandated
- Need to include in college catalog
- First step in a larger process toward capturing data on noncredit, particularly on completion



New TOP Codes

- For courses that serve students with disabilities (Noncredit; CB22 “E - Substantial Disabilities”)
- Currently, TOP Codes that reflect disabled student course content are reserved for Basic Skills courses only.
- Proposed Solution: Add three new TOP Codes
- Vetted through 5C (CCC Curriculum Committee)
- CCCCCO Academic Affairs and MIS currently working to implement (align COCI, MIS Data, TOP Code Manual, PCAH and other systems and resources)



New TOP Codes

Current Learning Disability TOP Codes	Proposed Learning Disability TOP Codes (Noncredit)
4930.30 - Learning Skills, Disabled	4930.34 - Basic Skills, Learning Skills, Disabled
4930.31 - Living Skills, Disabled	*
4930.32 - Learning Skills, Learning Disabled	4930.35 - Basic Skills, Learning Skills, Learning Disabled
4930.33 - Learning Skills, Speech Impaired	4930.36 - Basic Skills, Learning Skills, Speech Impaired

** New proposed TOP Codes does not include “Living Skills, Disabled”, as “Living Skills” is not a basic skill*



CCC Apply

- Understand concerns raised through advisory committees
- Legal Division is reviewing
- Weighing what is lost with a simpler form
- Carefully and thoroughly investigate options





CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGES

Integrating BSI, Student Equity, SSSP

- CCCCCO PRT for Student Services and Academic Affairs to integrate the three programs
- Development of first draft: Nov-Dec
- Stakeholder input: January
 - Workgroup of the major constituency groups
 - Draft shared and input gathered
- Undergoing final revisions



Integrating BSI, Student Equity, SSSP

- Plan will cover two years, 2017-18 and 2018-19
 - Release to field mid-February
 - First integrated plan due December 1, 2017
 - Requires district Board approval
- New expenditure guidelines
 - Flexibility for local decision making
 - Effective for 2016-17
- Two fiscal years to spend a single year allocation



Noncredit Advisory Committee

- Noncredit representatives on several CCCCCO advisory committees (5C, BSAC, NCSSSP, etc.)
 - Fragmented voice
- One committee to speak with one voice on noncredit issues
- Model for integrating advisory committees
- Stay tuned
